**PLANNING APPEAL - PROPOSED CREMATORIUM NEW INNS LANE APP/P1805/W/18/3211026**

Increased traffic on New Inns Lane and the close proximity to Reaside Junior School, where current building works have resulted in New Inns Lane being the main entrance to the school temporarily.

An industrial process taking place on green belt land.

A resident had emailed concerns around biodiversity and conservation.
