A home is a human right, but for many, a safe home is out of reach. Shelter is working to strengthen renters' rights and change the broken housing system to help end the housing emergency.

What we can help with at Shelter Birmingham:

- Advice on challenging homelessness decisions and unsuitable offers of accommodation / county court appeals on a point of law / accommodation pending a homeless application
- Support to resolve disrepair in rented properties
- Representation in court regarding possession of homes / evictions / ASBI
- Advice on notices asking you to leave your home / unlawful evictions or harassment
